## Chess lessons are back at TRES



Enkhbat Tegshsuren, **International Master**, experienced chess instructor, will continue teaching chess at T.R.E.S. Enkhbat (“EK”) has competed in several U.S Championships. He is one of the top players in the U.S with a chess rating over 2400.

**Intermediate Level (3:25 - 4:25 pm):** This chess class is for 1-5<sup>th</sup> grade students with some basic knowledge of the game such as checkmate, stalemate, castling, chess notation and chess tactics. Intermediate players will learn strategies on how to shape a plan in the middle game, combinations, and some endgame principles. Minimum 6 students/ Maximum 16 students.

**Beginner Level (4:30 - 5:30 pm):** This chess class is for 1-5<sup>th</sup> students who want to learn basic knowledge of chess: the moves of the pieces, relative values of chess pieces, opening principles, basic checkmates, and tactics like forks, pins, double attacks, and discovered checks. Minimum 6 students/ Maximum 16 students.

The cost of an 8-week session is \$65 and dates are on January 25, February 1, 8, 22, 29, March 7, 14, and 21, 2012. Classes will be held in the 4<sup>th</sup> Grade GT Classroom.

Please pick up your child promptly in the 4<sup>th</sup> Grade GT Classroom after class at 4:25 or 5:30. A note giving your child permission to attend must be sent in for each class.
